All roads lead to Aarhus and Diers Klinik

Going to Diers Klinik in Aarhus from most parts of UK and Ireland is easier and faster than you might think. Denmark is only a short flight away.

Traveling to Diers Klinik in Aarhus from various parts of the UK and Ireland is more convenient and quicker than you may realize, as Denmark is just a short flight away.

Whether you live around London, Manchester, Birmingham, Edinburgh, Aberdeen or Dublin you will be able to get a direct flight to Denmark.

Denmark is a small country with fairly short distances from A to B. A fine-meshed and efficient network of public transport options and toll-free roads make it easy, cheap, and fast to get to Diers Klinik in Aarhus from all Danish airports.

Direct flights to Denmark

Below we have made a list of the direct flight options to Denmark at the moment from UK and Ireland.

Flights from London

There are direct flights from London to:

- Aarhus
 - o <u>Ryanair</u> (from Stansted Airport)
 - <u>SAS</u> (from Heathrow Airport)

Both airlines have routes to Aarhus Airport several times a week.

- Billund
 - <u>Ryanair</u> (from Stansted Airport) flies to Billund Airport several times a day.
 - o <u>British Airways</u> (from Luton Airport) flies to Billund Airport several times a week.
- Aalborg
 - <u>Ryanair</u> (from Stansted Airport) flies to Aalborg Airport several times a week.
- Copenhagen
 - o <u>Ryanair</u> (from Stansted Airport)
 - <u>Norwegian</u> (from Gatwick Airport)
 - <u>easyJet</u> (from Gatwick Airport)
 - <u>SAS</u> (from Heathrow Airport)
 - o <u>British Airways</u> (from Heathrow)

All airlines have routes to Copenhagen Airport several times a week, some of them several times a day.



Flights from Manchester

There are direct flights from Manchester to:

- Billund
 - o <u>Ryanair</u>
 - o <u>British Airways</u>

Both airlines have routes to Billund Airport several times a week.

All airlines have routes to Copenhagen Airport several times a week, some of them several times a day.

Flights from Birmingham

There are direct flights from Birmingham to:

- Billund
 - o <u>Ryanair</u> flies to Billund Airport several times a week.
- Copenhagen
 - <u>SAS</u> flies to Copenhagen Airport every day.

Flights from Edinburgh

There are direct flights from Edinburgh to:

- Billund Airport
 - o <u>Ryanair</u> flies to Billund Airport several times a week.
- Copenhagen Airport
 - o <u>Ryanair</u>
 - o <u>easyJet</u>
 - o <u>Norwegian</u>

All airlines have routes to Copenhagen Airport several times a week.

Flights from Aberdeen

There are direct flights from Aberdeen to:

- Esbjerg
 - o Loganair flies to Esbjerg Airport several times a week



- Copenhagen
 - <u>SAS</u> flies to Copenhagen Airport several times a week

Flights from Dublin

There are direct flights from Dublin to:

All airlines have routes to Copenhagen Airport several times a week.

How do I get to Diers Klinik in Aarhus from the airport?

Diers Klinik in Aarhus is not far from any of the big airports in Denmark. We have made a detailed guide with our recommendations on how to get to Diers Klinik from each of the airports.

From Aarhus Airport to Aarhus city centre

By public transport

The cheapest way into the city is to take the **bus 925X**, which is an airport shuttle. It will take you directly to the main train station, Aarhus H, in downtown Aarhus.

The bus schedule is fixed with the airport arrivals and departures. The **travel time** into Aarhus is about **50 minutes**.

You can buy tickets on the bus (by card or cash) or from the Midttrafik App. The **fare** is **115 kr**. each way.

You can plan your journey <u>here</u>, and see further information about the bus route <u>here</u>.

Once you reach the station in Aarhus city centre it's just a short walk to Diers Klinik (12 minutes) and the hotels in the city centre.

By private transport

If you prefer to take taxi and rent a car it is also possible. The <u>drive to the clinic in Aarhus</u> <u>city</u> takes about 35 minutes.



Outside the airport, taxis are parked and waiting for passengers. Keep in mind that prices for the transfer are not fixed, but typically, a taxi ride from Aarhus Airport to the city centre will cost around 650 DKK.

When traveling from central Aarhus to the airport, it is advisable to pre-book a taxi to pick you up. <u>Aarhus Taxa</u> and <u>Dantaxi</u> are among the popular taxi companies that offer this service.

If you want to drive to Aarhus city centre yourself, there are several <u>car rental companies</u> at Aarhus Airport to choose from.

From Billund Airport to Aarhus city centre

By public transport

An easy and cheap way to Aarhus city is to take the bus 912X. It will take you directly to the main station, Aarhus H, in downtown Aarhus.

The bus schedule is (usually) every one hour on weekdays and every second hour on weekends. The travel time into Aarhus is about 1 hour and 30 minutes.

You can buy tickets on the bus (by card or cash) or from the Midttrafik App. The fare is 162 kr. each way.

You can plan your journey <u>here</u>, and see further information about the bus route <u>here</u>.

Once you reach <u>the station in Aarhus city centre</u> it's just <u>a short walk to Diers Klinik</u> (12 minutes) and the hotels in the city centre.

By private transport

If you prefer to take taxi and rent a car it is also possible. The <u>drive to the clinic in Aarhus</u> <u>city</u> takes about 1 hour and 15 minutes.

Outside the airport, you will find the taxi rank. Keep in mind that prices for the transfer are not fixed, and it's not cheap either. Typically, a taxi ride from Billund Airport to Aarhus city centre will cost around 1500 DKK.

When traveling from central Aarhus to the airport, it is advisable to pre-book a taxi to pick you up. <u>Aarhus Taxa</u> and <u>Dantaxi</u> are among the popular taxi companies that offer this service.

Do you want to rent a car and drive to Aarhus city centre yourself, there are several <u>car</u> rental companies at Billund Airport to choose from.



From Aalborg Airport to Aarhus city centre

By public transport

The easiest way from Aalborg Airport to Aarhus is to take the train. You can jump on the train next to the airport, and it will take you – either directly or with one train change - to the main train station, Aarhus H, in downtown Aarhus.

The train ride from Aalborg Airport to Aarhus H takes approximately 1 hour and 45 minutes, depending on the time of day and any potential stops/changes.

The fare price for the train route can vary, but it is typically between 60-250 DKK each way. It's a good idea to purchase your train ticket in advance as the prices tend to increase on the day of travel.

You can plan your journey and check the schedule and prices <u>here</u> or on the DSB app.

Once you reach <u>Aarhus H</u> you are just a <u>short walk (12 minutes) from Diers Klinik</u> and the hotels in the city centre.

Another option is to go by bus, train or taxi to the bus station in Aalborg city centre and take the Flixbus to Aarhus from there.

The busses number 12, 69, 70, 71 and 200 drive to Aalborg bus station (or nearby). Tickets for the bus to Aalborg city can be purchased at the ticket machine right next to the main entrance at the airport before exit. The travel time into Aalborg bus station is 15-25 minutes depending on the stops. The fare price is around 20 DKK.

The direct Flixbus route from Aalborg bus station to Aarhus runs several times a day, and the travel time is about 1 hour and 25 minutes depending on the stops on the route.

If you book your tickets for the Flixbus in advance, prices start from 70 DKK each way. Prices can be higher, though, depending on the time of booking.

You can plan your Flixbus journey here.

Once you reach <u>Aarhus H</u> you are just a <u>short walk (12 minutes) from Diers Klinik</u> and the hotels in the city centre.

By private transport

If you prefer to rent a car it is also possible. The drive <u>from Aalborg Airport to the clinic in</u> <u>Aarhus city</u> takes about 1 hour and 20 minutes depending on the time of the day.

At Aalborg Airport there are several <u>car rental companies</u> to choose from.



From Copenhagen Airport to Aarhus city centre

By public transport

We suggest taking the Flixbus as the most convenient and economical means of transport from Copenhagen Airport to Aarhus city centre.

The direct Flixbus route to Aarhus runs several times a day, and the travel time is about 4 hours depending on the stops on the route.

If you book your tickets in advance, prices start from 120 DKK each way or even lower. Prices can be higher, though, depending on the time of booking.

The <u>Flixbus stop</u> is outside the airport at Ellehammersvej, in front of the car park P10.

You can plan your Flixbus journey here.

Once you reach <u>the bus station in Aarhus city centre</u> it's just <u>a short walk to Diers Klinik</u> (12 minutes) and the hotels in the city centre.

If the Flixbus schedule does not match with your flight arrival or if you prefer travelling by train, the train from Copenhagen Airport to Aarhus H (main train station in Aarhus city centre) is an excellent alternative. The train runs more frequently, and the train platform is right next to the arrival hall in the airport.

The train ride from Copenhagen Airport to Aarhus H takes approximately 3 hours, depending on the time of day and any potential stops/changes.

The fare price for the train route can vary, but it is typically between 150-400 DKK each way. It's a good idea to purchase your train ticket in advance as the prices tend to increase on the day of travel.

Once you reach <u>Aarhus H</u> you are just a <u>short walk (12 minutes) from Diers Klinik</u> and the hotels in the city centre.

By private transport

If you prefer to drive to Aarhus city centre yourself, there are <u>several car rental options</u> at Copenhagen Airport.

There are two different routes from Copenhagen Airport by car to Aarhus to choose from – a bridge option and a ferry option.



The bridge option is generally faster and more direct, as you don't have to wait for the ferry connection. However, the ferry option offers a scenic and relaxing journey through the Danish fjords. Ultimately, the choice between the two will depend on your personal preferences.

Route option 1: Crossing the Storebælt Bridge

This route will take you across the Storebælt Bridge, which is a suspension bridge that connects the islands of Zealand and Funen in Denmark. The journey takes approximately 3 hours.

The toll for a one-way trip crossing the Storebælt Bridge for a standard car is 270 DKK. There are various discounts available. Check out the <u>prices and discount options here</u>.

Route option 2: By boat from Sjællands Odde

This route will take you by ferry from Sjællands Odde on the northwest part of Sjælland to Aarhus city.

The ferry journey takes approximately 1 hour and 20 minutes, and you'll arrive directly in Aarhus city just a short walk from the clinic. The total journey time is approximately 3 hours.

The price for the ferry varies depending on the time of day and season. A one-way ticket for a standard car costs between 250 and 650 DKK. You can <u>plan your ferry journey here</u>.

I can be difficult to find parking in the streets near the clinic, so we suggest you park in one of the parking garages nearby:

- <u>The parking facilities</u> under the shopping mall Magasin is <u>4 minutes' walk</u> from Diers Klinik
- <u>The Navitas parking facilities</u> is <u>10 minutes' walk</u> from Diers Klinik.

From Esbjerg Airport to Aarhus city centre

By public transport

Depending on the time of day there are different options of travelling to Aarhus by bus and train or a combination of bus/train.

We suggest you plan your journey <u>here</u> or on Google maps when you know the time of arrival of your flight.

The travel time is usually just under 3 hours. Fare prices start from around 170 DKK.

Once you reach <u>Aarhus H</u> you are just a <u>short walk (12 minutes) from Diers Klinik</u> and the hotels in the city centre.



By private transport

If you prefer to rent a car it is also possible. Check the <u>car rental options</u> here. The drive from <u>Esbjerg Airport to the clinic in Aarhus city</u> takes about 1 hour and 45 minutes.

At Aalborg Airport there are several <u>car rental companies</u> to choose from.

Parking near the clinic

I can be difficult to find parking in the streets near the clinic, so we suggest you park in one of the parking garages nearby:

- The Navitas parking facilities is <u>10 minutes' walk</u> from Diers Klinik
- <u>The parking facilities</u> under the shopping mall Magasin is <u>4 minutes' walk</u> from Diers Klinik

If you arrive by boat from Sjællands Odde, we suggest you choose Navitas as it is right next to the ferry terminal.
